BIOGRAPHY: Since learning to fly over 20 years ago, Christine "CC" Gerner has logged over 13,000 hours of flight time in a variety of aircraft ranging from antique biplanes to state of the art Transport Category Airliners.

Although her substantial aviation experience extends from General Aviation to Corporate, Commuter and Major Airlines, it was her early years as a professional Alpine Skier that was instrumental in developing the focus and drive for which she is now known. No stranger to speed and adrenaline, she was once clocked at 104 MPH on downhill skies!

That, along with her training in gymnastics and diving, made it only natural that, when introduced to aviation, she would gravitate to the high energy, adrenalin packed world of Unlimited Aerobatics.

CC endures +8 / -7 G's during her routine. She weighs 120#, so you can see that she approaches over 900# of weight during her routine.

CC grew up in San Francisco, CA about 8 miles from the SFO airport and rode her bicycle to and from the SFO airport daily just to watch airplanes.

CC's father was a Canadian who migrated to the US during WWII and became a pilot in the Army Air Corp. He instructed in Stearman Aircraft and finished the war flying the TBM "Avenger". Her father discouraged her from flying and told her "Girls don't fly". She takes delight in proving him wrong everyday!

Now with years of airshow performances under her belt, CC has become a household name on the Airshow circuit and continues to amaze spectators with her athletic approach to aerobatics. She is qualified for both solo and formation aerobatic routines at the surface level by the FAA.

When not flying airshows, CC flies a Boeing 747-400 aircraft for Delta Airlines. and lives in Lakeville, Minnesota.
